### On Site Graduation Information

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Thank you for your interest in attending our 2018 graduation service for Andersonville Theological Seminary. We know this is an exciting time in your life and we look forward to sharing it with you. The ceremony will take place on Friday, May 25, 2018 at 2:00 p.m. (EST).

Below we have outlined the information that you need in categories. Please be sure to read each one carefully.

#### **Signing Up to Attend**

All students who wish to attend are required to fill out the [Intent to Attend Graduation Form](#) located on our website ([www.andersonvilleseminary.com](http://www.andersonvilleseminary.com)) under the FORMS tab. Once a student fills out that form and sends it to the seminary, he or she will start receiving emails regarding graduation. Please respond to each email letting the office know that you received the updated information.

Note: Bulk emails will be sent with updates. These bulk emails may display the emails of all students coming to graduation. Students often email about meeting for a meal, etc.

#### **What to Expect at Graduation**

Graduation service includes all of the following:

- Special music for 1 hour prior to the ceremony
- Welcome and introductions by James Hayes
- A sermon to charge the graduates by Dr. Jimmy Hayes, president of the seminary or a guest speaker
- Presentation of degrees
- Pictures with Dr. Jimmy Hayes as the graduate receives his or her degree
- A group picture of the graduating class

The service usually lasts about 2 hours, not including the 1 hour of special music prior to the ceremony. A normal on site graduating class usually consists of around 100 graduates with up to 900 people in attendance.

## **Things to do before Graduation**

- Fill out the Intent to Attend Form described above
- Order invitations for your friends and family (optional – see below)
- Order your cap and gown (see information under Cap and Gown heading below)
- Make sure you have paid all tuition, turned in all your work, ordered your degree, and checked with the office to make sure you have been cleared to graduate. Previous transcripts must be on file before receiving degree. **ALL FEES AND WORK MUST BE COMPLETED BY APRIL 15<sup>TH</sup>.**

## **Ordering Invitations**

Invitations are a great way to let friends and family know of your accomplishment. They are also great to frame or put in your scrapbook. Graduates may order invitations at [www.andersonvilleseminary.com](http://www.andersonvilleseminary.com). ## **Ordering the Cap and Gown**

For the convenience of our students, Brooks Davis, sells cap and gowns for the ceremony. To order, go to [www.andersonvilleseminary.com](http://www.andersonvilleseminary.com) and click on the FORMS tab. You will find information on graduation regalia. The order form will give you the information you need. Orders for the May graduation will not be taken until after **January 1, 2018.**

Brooks Davis is only responsible for the cap and gown orders placed with him. He will not be able to help you if you order your cap and gown from someone else.

## **Graduation Pictures**

Heritage Photography will be making pictures starting at 10:00 a.m. on graduation day. They will continue to make individual pictures until approximately 1:30 p.m. Dressing rooms are available for graduates to change. The graduation picture packet is \$100 and must be paid with cash, money order, or check. Checks are made to Heritage Photography.

## **Videos**

Videos will be made during the ceremony and will be on sale for \$40.00. Students will be able to purchase the videos on the day of the ceremony. Videos will be mailed out in 6 to 8 weeks. Please make all checks or money orders out to Jerry White.

## **Degrees**

Students do not receive their degree during the graduation ceremony. Degrees are mailed out every month as students graduate. Many of those attending graduation will have already received their degree. Others will have arranged to pick up their degree at check in on graduation day. Some may have been late ordering their degree and will not receive it until later. During the graduation ceremony, each graduate will receive a certificate of participation.

## **Instructions for Graduation Day**

On graduation day, graduates should check in at 10:00 a.m. Please enter through the side door at the north end of the auditorium. Once inside, you will do the following:

- Sign in at the registration table.
- Pick up any degrees.
- Continue to the next station in the main lobby where you will be able to purchase a DVD of graduation, frames with school seal, mugs, T-shirts, tags, and other school memorabilia.
- Continue to the photography station for graduation portraits. Dressing rooms are available for changing.
- After completing these tasks, graduates will be dismissed to have lunch with family and friends.
- Report back to the auditorium by 1:00 p.m. Seating instructions will be given to graduates at check-in. Please do not be late!!! You will enjoy the music during your wait and allow the lower level seats to be taken by friends and family.
- Shortly before 2:00, graduates will be escorted into the auditorium to be seated in a reserved seating area.
- After the ceremony, graduates will march outside for a group photo.
