## Honors Scale for All Graduate and Doctoral Programs

3.95—4.00 Highest Distinction (Gold medallion with gold ribbon)

3.75—3.94 Distinction (Silver medallion with white ribbon)

Upon completion of all financial and academic requirements, students potentially may be eligible for honors. The ATS Registrar’s Office will notify the student if eligible for honors. If eligible, students may purchase an honors medallion when purchasing their graduation regalia and/or accessories. All undergraduate honors medallions currently are gold 2” medallions with red/white/blue ribbons. Graduate/Doctoral honors medallions are as follows: with “Highest Distinction” is a gold 2.25” medallion with a gold ribbon; with “Distinction” is a silver 2.25” medallion with a white ribbon. Both of the Graduate/Doctoral medallions are imprinted with ATS School Seal. Graduate/Doctoral honors medallions pictured below.
